- Stop by the North Creek Mosaic Project - the largest piece of public art in the Adirondacks.
- Explore local art, watch a concert, or take a class at the Tannery Pond Community Center.
- Try something totally new! Book a glassblowing class with Adirondack Glassblowing Studio.
- The North Creek Farmers Market is open rain or shine (it's covered!) from 2–5:30 PM **every Thursday** at Riverfront Park at Railroad Place.
- The Town of Johnsburg Library offers game nights, movie nights, and plenty of rainy-day reads.
